Bro. H, Sis M, their daughter L, arrived in USA safely last week, after 18 months of fear and persecution in Iran and Turkey. And further, a few days later, the UN gave approval for the emigration of the remaining Christadelphian refugees in Iran from Turkey! They will some time within the next few months God willing be moving to the West too. The whole group who have worked with them cannot describe in words our joy, our tears, our gratitude. For all our dysfunctions at times, we believe that our Lord has powerfully worked- through your prayers, generous donations, willing efforts to get background information, perhaps especially, humanly speaking, through your 2500 petitions which we presented to the UN in Geneva earlier in the year, through the miraculous 'co-incidence' of our dear sister Sonia being present, through the many visits made to our brethren...it has all worked together for good.

The newly arrived family, who were amongst the most 'wanted' by their persecutors out of all the Iranians, arrived a short time after Sis. Z and her daughter arrived in USA where she was met on arrival by Bro. Steve.

Liz, Marcus and Duncan were able to meet with our newly arrived brother and sisters in the USA. It was the first time we had been together with them in a safe environment. We cannot express the emotion and gratitude which we felt. Truly there is a God in Israel, who is alive and active for His people, and who blesses richly all sincere efforts for Him. We were kindly driven to meet them where they are temporarily staying in Tennessee by a local brother, we broke bread together, and we are so grateful for the fact that they are soon to relocate to an ecclesia in Illinois and a new life in the Lord's service. We wish to thank all the American brethren and sisters who have worked so hard and continue to do so for them. It was wonderful to break bread next to a lake in Tennessee, remembering the many other times in Iran and Turkey when we had broken bread in constant fear and uncertainty as to the future. We recalled that it was only in May this year that Bro. H had SMS texted us when it looked as if all was coming to an end for them: "Don't worry please we must trust God I am ready for everything even face death please read Rom 5:3-6 God bless". And now, they are safe. Praise, praise to our Father.
