Abedi suffered great things in refugee camps in Africa, and informed us of his plight. Through your prayers, donations, and the great work and initiatives / connections of so many, Sister Sonia Hemingray & Brother Clive Solomon especially, our brother and his family made the long journey from West Africa to South America. Esther reports that although the family are happy, living as a new immigrant in a developing country like Guyana has many problems for them all. Comparing the two photographs below, however, is a cause for thanks to our Almighty Father. There this family were, suffering unmentionable things in deprived conditions, and now here they are joyfully standing outside the Kilcoy Ecclesial Hall in Guyana, as recently photographed by Esther:



At the same time, we continue providing help to those in Eastern Europe who are in difficulty as a result of their faith. The family we're assisting in Latvia have now planted crops for the Summer, now the frosts have gone, to make use of the short growing season. Using blankets as curtains is a bit much when you have so many children to bed each night, so we were happy to provide blankets and more bedding yesterday to a rather harried Sis. Lia:
