SISTER NINA

Nina was the daughter of an underground Christian in the Soviet Union, her father was taken to a labour camp and never heard of again. She shared with us how she and the other believers in her town would pass around typescripts of the Russian translation of the notes in the Scofield Reference Bible, and would retype them on an old typewriter with 5 pieces of carbon paper in between the sheets, so you had to really bang each letter hard. She knows the notes really very well. She was herself arrested and beaten, and this has resulted in some memory loss especially regarding the middle period of her life. She now has no family and is unable to survive on her state pension so is living in a shelter. She is quite OK mentally, but had become very distressed that she can't remember whether or not she'd been baptized. She asked around whether anyone knows a Bible loving church who practice baptism and who are non-Trinitarian. She was put on to us by a cleaner she knows who knows us, and so she made contact. And today we were able to baptize her into the Lord Jesus as she so dearly wished. She had no Bible of her own, only a New Testament. She asked if she could buy one from us, having saved a heap of coins towards this. It was of course our pleasure to give her one. It's rare to see someone so appreciative of a Bible- she hugged and cuddled it when we gave it to her, and eagerly reads it each day using the "Bible Companion" plan. We very much feel tools in the Lord's hands as He gathers His people unto Himself in these last days.
