By the age of 21, her parents and three siblings had all died from various illnesses, accidents and one from the war in Afghanistan. She realizes she really is a survivor, and for a long time has wondered "why?" and searched for Truth in the Bible, although her weak eyesight has slowed her in her search for understanding. It was great to see our almost blind brother Vladimir baptize her, inevitably one thinks of 'the blind leading the blind', but in this case, to the Kingdom:



The mothers and toddlers group is growing fast. It lasts for a whole morning, and during this time the women do an activity together and Cindy seeks to teach them some Biblical first principles.

## **MOROCCO**

We were unable to baptize some contacts on our recent trip to Morocco, due to last minute problems created by Moslem extremists trying to sabotage our work.
