We really can do with more help to keep our work going, both financially and in terms of boots on the ground.





Our online following continues significantly. This weekend we had a great time in Manchester, together with some youngsters from the Old Trafford ecclesia. We met with and baptized JOHN near Bury. A typical young British male who had not been raised Christian, he had turned to the Lord after his life hit a very low point. And started reading the Bible. We had a long chat and he begged us to come baptize him. But he was going away on a holiday for 2 weeks... and it was a cruise. So it was with great joy we finally got to meet John, and baptized him in a spot of his choice- despite the very cold water. He was absolutely so joyful afterwards, so moved.
