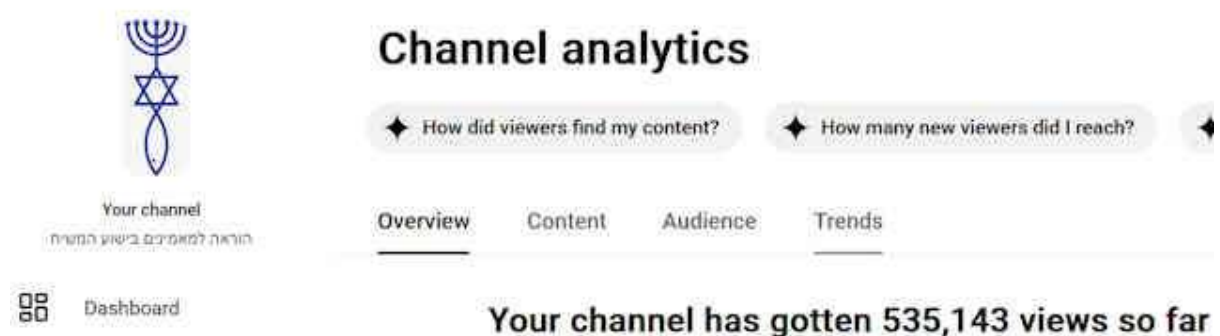
AUSTRALIA

ISRAEL

We continue our advertising in Israel and are open to any specific donations towards our work there. Our Hebrew language version of the Bible Companion app has about 2000 users in Israel. Our Hebrew language YouTube channel has had over half a million views... and that's in addition to folks in Israel who engage with us in English and Russian [there are many Russian speakers in Israel]. This is very significant engagement. We do get response, often from Orthodox Jewish men who aren't supposed to have smartphones... who have become secret believers in Jesus as Messiah, but feel they just can't "come out" in their faith as it they would lose their families, have to go to work when they have no workplace skills, and become liable for army service. Interestingly, our encouragement of them to get baptized secretly isn't meeting any takers. They all say that to be a Christian is to "come out" openly, and they're not wrong really.



If you attend our Saturday morning breaking of bread, you can meet with brother Alex whom we baptized last time from the app... he is quite different in background and very open about his Christian faith.

More recently we were approached by a woman called OR [which means "light" in English] who earnestly wanted to be baptized into Jesus as Messiah, having come to Him some time ago but was disappointed by churches. Our sister is very fervent in her faith and has spoken with us and with Cindy by phone, expressing her clear understanding and devotion to the Lord Jesus. It is with great joy that we can now tell you that she has been baptized into the Lord Jesus! Her grandfather was a Rabbi and so this has been a massive personal shift for her. No photos for various reasons, but do pray for our sister. She says she feels a light [her name means "light"] in the darkness of secular Israeli society, and indeed that is how it is. Spiritual life there isn't easy.

UK

We had a great time up in Leeds, baptizing ASH, a roofer who got in contact with a sister from Croydon and she directed him to the Lord and to baptism. And what a wonderfully sincere man, very aware that his Church of England baptizing by sprinkling wasn't the right thing, and having read his Bible and turned very much to the Lord, now wants to walk strongly with Him. Such a sincere man. Brother Billy drove down from Middlesbrough to spend the day with us, and we were just so very encouraged by his growth in faith and spiritual maturity.
