We're pleased to report the baptism of KASPAR at the **Riga Bible Center** this week. Our new brother lives in one of the large apartment blocks local to the hall. He became interested in the Bible during the Communist period but lost interest after he saw people he knew arrested and deported to labour camps for the Christian faith. Now, many years later, he recalled his desire for baptism and sought to study the Bible from scratch. He was really so pleased to be baptized.

Cindy's women's and children's group got permission to plant a heart of flowers in the park opposite the street where the Bible Center is located. Although some of the plants were stolen soon after planting, it is still an impressive witness and attracted much attention to our preaching work:

As the lorry can only get to the top of their drive this will involve some walking and carrying, although the boxes themselves are not very heavy if taken one at a time... So if you can come along that day and / or motivate any able bodies to help that day, that would be great... There really is a need here. Marcus & Gwladys live in a small bungalow and are unable to provide food but drinks will be available. Please email us if you can help or give them a call on 0208 657 1358.
