AUSTRALIA

Do come and support in **Gatton QLD** if you can; Phil and Miri Worsnop report:

"We have just had the approval from the Gatton Show Society to have a stand God Willing on the 19 20 July, Gatton in is the Lockyer Valley (40min drive up the highway from Ipswich), which covers agricultural communities .. This also results in many different nationalities as workers/ backpackers and refugee backgrounds. We also received 2 boxes of NT Bibles. Sis Katie needed 10 of these,(Katie rides her bike around Ipswich displaying her 'free Bible vest')"



Our distribution of *Creation calendars* and Bibles in Australian prisons has continued to bring forth fruit.

UK

We reported earlier the baptism of brother Emmanuel, a Ghanaian living in the Birmingham area. Our brother recently returned to Ghana for a holiday and took with him some boxes of *NEV Bibles*, which he was able to distribute to family and friends. He's very excited about the response, and sent these photos, including of some of the Bibles being put in sacks to be taken to very remote rural areas:



We reported at the time how hard it was to make his baptism, with a car breakdown and long traffic jam en route to it. Now that brother is bringing forth spiritual fruit in parts of darkest Africa.

We ask for your prayers for several people in the **UK** who are seriously considering baptism at this time.

We mentioned last time that Br Jim Sis Anne Barton made an amazing witness, singing Gospel music at the Bluegrass Festival in Ontario. They interspersed their songs with a good

presentation of the Gospel, to a good sized audience.

LATVIA

LATVIA WOMEN'S CAMP

Cindy plans to run another of her Summer camps for women and children at the large property in northern Latvia which Carelinks support. Not sparing Cindy's blushes, over the years Cindy has brought a number of secular younger women to baptism into Christ through her witness in daily life. They all have children, and they all have friends to whom they in turn are sharing the Gospel. They will spend four days or so together, with Bible studies, breaking of bread and activities for the children. And other sisters in Latvia are also invited. As not everyone can contribute towards the food nor the transport there, we're appealing for 400 Euro towards this.

It is planned for the end of June, God willing. Any long distance visitors are of course welcome although it's not conducted in English. Last year the theme was the fruit of the Spirit:



Our feeding and teaching sessions continue at the *Bible center*. There are some great success stories. Sister Tanya was homeless, moving between sleeping on the streets to sleeping in various night shelters. After her baptism last year she really changed, and never misses a Sunday meeting, specializing in cleaning the toilets afterwards. She got a job on a production line in a factory, and has been there for over 6 months now, although the work is hard and very low paid. She's now been allowed by the council to live in a flat, which is the first time for years she's had a place of her own. It is just two rooms with no toilet or kitchen, but we've assisted her to get the rooms set up with at least a sink and hot water, and got her a kettle and other things. It is such transformations of life which assure us that God wishes us to continue what is at times a very resource demanding work.
