Please do pray for our brother Simon, an **Iranian** refugee brother we baptized a couple of years ago. Greece is particularly hostile to asylum seekers. He has no documents and is currently imprisoned. Please pray for all our asylum seeker brothers and sisters in Christ who are in prison. Our brother has access to a cell phone in his prison cell, and we therefore could call him and sing "Be bold, be strong" for him. The UK brothers and sisters currently working at *Riga Bible Center* have Fridays as their day off and so were able to gather together and sing and give messages to him via a Skype-out call to the cell phone. We're happy to share his cell phone number with anyone else who might be able to encourage our brother, or perhaps do what we did and organize a group to briefly sing to him or give him encouraging messages. UKRAINE

Please continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in the Ukraine; even if not directly threatened by violence at this moment, there are many financial and practical hardships associated with living in a large country of 46 million people that is paralyzed and has no effective ruling structure. We have produced some research seeking to specifically locate Ukraine in Bible prophecy, and we submit that this is the first time such material has been brought to the attention of the brotherhood. This week we're pleased to report yet more fruit from the *Riga Bible Center*, in the baptisms of ANDREJ and SVETLANA. They were such different people, with very different smells, the perfume of a woman who has a job and comes to us because she is attracted to our Biblical

teaching and loves reading the *NEV Bible with commentary* she was given, and the smell of a desperately sincere Russian man who lives the night shelter / on the street life, was therefore grateful for the meals we provide, and yet now far more so for the hope of the Gospel he encountered. We again repeat our appeal for you to continue supporting this work in prayer and donation, and to prayerfully talk to folks, or yourselves consider, the possibility of coming over at the end of March to help continue the momentum that is going on in Riga. There is a very real need being met, as well as a wonderful opportunity to teach the Gospel to genuinely interested people.
