Fred put on his best clothes this Saturday [Sabbath] and went to the park to give a talk to a few folks milling around there, here's a still from the video:



Please pray for their growth and witness. It's great that the Gospel is being taught in that very deprived area of God's special land. Fred came to us from seeing Mike Duncan wearing the high visibility "*Free Bibles*" vests. They had distributed all the New Testaments they could carry, and were returning to their accommodation but had kept the vests on. And so Fred noticed them when riding his bicycle and stopped to ask if he could have one. We didn't have any to give him right then, but we had a good chat and took his phone number and entered into correspondence by *WhatsApp* and then arranged further meetings where we gave him literature. The high visibility vests are really a good idea, as interested people come up to you, rather than you needing to accost people who may have no idea why you want to talk to them. As mentioned above, Jim Barton has been usefully using this approach in Canada as we have elsewhere. You can make up the vests yourself, or we have some in stock. People like Fred are out there, asking the right questions and not finding the answers in standard churchianity.
