### GERMANY

#### IRAN / ISRAEL

Our prayers continue for our brethren and contacts in both Israel and Iran, as well as the Gulf States generally. We've stepped up advertising the Bible Companion app in Israel- sitting in bomb shelters, people do tend to think about God, life, death etc.- and they also sit there playing with their phones. There's usually internet and power available in the shelters. So... they can see our adverts and hopefully sit there looking at the Bible app.

needed. But we always say, we'd rather see you than your money. Those recently baptized really need this weekend to grow spiritually and get to know others in the Lord's body. And do come along yourselves, pray for us, and encourage others to attend!

A great day at pub Church on Sunday, with all eyes on the situation with Israel and Iran fulfilling Bible prophecy. Sermon specifically on Psalm 83 and the latter day invasion of Israel at <https://youtu.be/PxjMbYmJ5Vg> . We dwelt very much on the calm assurance there is in the Lord Jesus, if we are secure in Him. After church a good number came back to the Heaster home for the baptism of KIMBERLEY, who stopped attending our meetings a couple of years ago after she lost her baby but has now returned. After the baptism service, we invite all present to give their testimony and say some words of encouragement to the new brother or sister, and along with the baptism we videoed our dear sister Sis giving her testimony and message, along with singing a song to our new sister. So many who crowded into the bathroom to witness the baptism had themselves been baptized in that same bath tub. That extra large, deep bath tub was out of fashion when we bought it, so it was on special offer... we were advised to get a shallow, low wall bath as they were more popular. We told the shop assistant "No, we hope to be doing many baptisms in it, so, we want the old fashioned deep ones". And so it turned out, under God's good hand.





And it was so nice to have three new faces with us who had all met us at our open air meeting we reported last week. It's so great when open air witnessing work translates into visitors at meetings, especially three people. Do come along and get out on the streets with us, as we feel we must do more of this, given such results.

It was also rather touching to get a simple thank you card from some of the original group who first gathered with us at the Orchard Pub at our first meeting there some years ago now. It's amazing that so many in the bar that first Sunday... still attend, and have all been baptized.

After the success of last week's open air meetings, we tried another one this week, moving from central Croydon to West Croydon. The crossroads where we set up our microphone is in the midst of a neighbourhood that has one of the highest rates of knife crime and drug-related crime in the UK. The smell of drugs is everywhere. And so we gave a series of talks and distributed invitations to our meetings to all manner of folks there.
