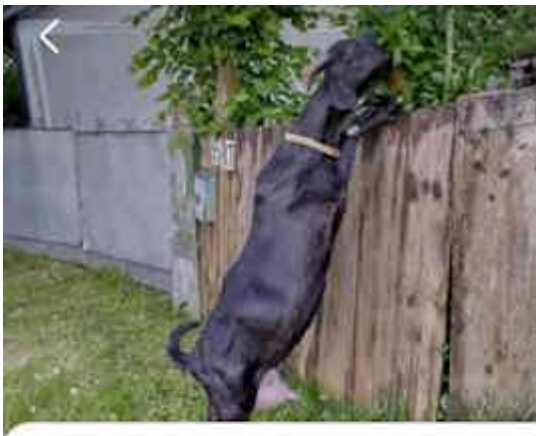


May 2026 Ukraine, UK

Thanks to everyone for the advice about relactating sister Svitlana's goats. Some great ideas but she's tried some of them and no progress. Goats are great for someone like her, driven to subsistence farming after the family home was destroyed near the front line. They eat anything, and can be left outside most Winters. The Winter however was extremely harsh this year in Ukraine with temperatures down to - 40 C and it seems her goats stopped lactating after that. And they're old. For goats. Various people offer goats for sale in Ukraine, but it's not exactly a mail order situation and hard to tell what you're really buying. They also need transporting out to her place, and those advertised aren't at all cheap [prices in Ukrainian Hryvna]. So, we'll Lord willing try to sort this a bit later in the Summer so she hopefully is all set for milk [and therefore cheese etc.] when the Winter comes:
