All our brothers and sisters in Chile are alive but as explained below, definitely affected by the tragic earthquake. Sister Gisella was baptized as a result of *Bible Basics* outreach some years ago:

*"To feel your love and concern has helped us during all these hard moments. Since last Saturday when we suffered the earthquake it keeps moving every 5 hours and it is around 5 or 6 grades every time. The first 3 days we slept into the car because we thought the roof could fall down, then we decided to stay inside the house but Jeremy and me are sleeping in jeremyacute;s room under the bed and ready to run away quicky as soon as we could feel another movement. Everybody is scared, the supermarkets and gas stations are collapsed because everybody wants to buy a lot of food and gas for the car, other people is stealing from homes or supermarkets or the malls, you can not work or continue your life normally because Chile is still moving and everytime you turn on the tv you hear about bad news. However, I am sure that God is blessing brothers and sisters in Chile because all of us suffered lack of some important needs, water, Light, phone line but our homes, relatives and everything around us is still okay. If you can talk to other brothers and sisters about us please ask them to pray for chilean people and for us. Jeremy has been very brave and has helped me a lot, he is telling me all the time that God and him is going to take care of us.
