And of course apart from the love of the Father and His Son, that is all of us- if only we would perceive it.

### **LATVIA**

Sometimes it seems the hand of providence through the Angels works to some kind of pattern, developing a kind of theme; because also this week we were able to baptize S in Riga, originally from Afghanistan, and also the result of persistent witness to him by an Iranian brother for two years. We hope his wife and family will also respond to the Gospel in due course.
