### LATVIA

We have mentioned in previous reports the amazing witnessing work achieved by brother Ivar in the isolated care home he lived in in rural Latvia. Many were baptized there as a result of his witness- a man who can barely talk, whose speech is hard to understand, who is not online and yet who uses hard copies of our publications to preach to all and sundry. Our brother has been moved from that care home to another one. It was a joy to visit him there and baptize his room mate ROBERTS. His clothes are provided by the institution and have holes in them [see photo], and yet our brother's deep, almost trembling respect for God's word is the main thing in his life:



We plan on giving them a laptop computer- there's no internet, but in response to the previous appeal, some old computers have been loaded with video , MP3 and text files of our various materials in Russian. This could really open a new life for them. We've heard from brother Shurik in far Eastern Latvia that he has received the laptop sent- and is busy trying to figure how to use it. He too is in a care facility.

### USA

The backbone of our preaching work is the distribution of books such as *Bible Basics*, *The Real Christ*, *The Real Devil*, *the NEV Bible with Commentary*, *Introducing Bible Basics* etc. Although these days the cost of postage is so very high, a long term witness has been made by the distribution of so many hard copy publications over many years now. These days, in addition to the few hundreds of thousands of hard copies, there are hundreds of thousands of people who have viewed the material and many have downloaded it. And fruit keeps on being reaped from this work, to the Lord's glory. We were delighted to get this news from Baltimore, which is quite typical:

*"I have the happiest news! About 12 years ago a lady in Baltimore downloaded **Bible Basics**, had classes with my mother in law over the phone, was baptized. Yesterday her son Scott was baptized! He is a prince of a guy! Scott is married to a girl from La Paz and they have a young son, James. Next week they are all heading down to Bolivia for the month. There is a little meeting in the city and they plan to attend".*



As so often, we notice that the Lord intends to spread His Truth far and wide through many of those who are being baptized recently. We'd like to thank all those who have enabled the distribution of literature and also those who have worked so hard on developing and maintaining our internet outreach. God has surely blessed the efforts.

## **KENYA**

Brothers John & Guy from New Zealand are currently in Kenya , working with the Kisuya family and other local contacts in Western Kenya. They have taken with them brother Austin from Malawi in order to give him wider experience and hands-on training in how to pastor the new ecclesias in Malawi which have arisen [as explained previously] from the consequences of the baptism of a married couple from Malawi whilst studying in Norway. They report:

*"The first study group finished today and left about 2.30 pm and were a very good group - a few shining lights who you can tell from their body language really clicked onto the new doctrine and the sense of it.*

*Kingdom of God - John*

*The importance of truth - Greg*

*The devil - John*

*Israel and the Jews - part 1 - Greg*

*Biblical Praise - John*

*Second day - today*

*Greg finished Israel talk*

*The nature of God - John*

*Finding the will of God - John*

*After the classes we walked around Bungoma - bought more notebooks and pens for next session tomorrow, and at the bookshop we saw they sold bibles that we get from Kisumu. Bargained with the lady and she will sell to us for the same price as we pay in Kisumu so Amos can get them from here which is only 30 mins drive rather than 3 hours. It is good seeing Austin from Malawi with us and enjoying the fellowship".*

Please do continue praying for them as they hold out the true Gospel to many.
