Brother Aleksandr collects glass bottles and gets the deposit back on them, and he proudly announced that he has saved enough to buy himself not only a warm Winter coat but also gloves, hat and shoes. TABLETS / LAPTOPS

We have several Russian speaking bre & sis in care facilities or old folks' homes where they have little to do all day; many are in rural areas and scarcely ever are visited. We have large numbers of videos and MP3 audio files, but they have neither computer nor internet access. We were wondering if anyone has old laptops or tablets which they could pre-load with our Russian language material [we can direct you to the websites where it is]. Then, you could post the machine out to the brother or sister. It would give them a greater sense of fellowship to be able to play videos of our meetings and to break bread along with us, even if not in real time. The

machines wouldn't need to be internet-ready, just to have a functioning sound and video card.
