### **HEALTH ISSUES**

Just at this moment there are a number of brothers and sisters in need of our prayer support as they face serious illness with no funds to pay for treatment. Brother Viktor continues to be visited by members of Riga ecclesia and we are regularly paying for his care; he is making very slow progress in recovering from his stroke but is still unable to feed himself or move much. Brother Alexei has been in much pain due to a failed hip replacement operation, but has been saving from his pension, sold his old car, and his sons are working in Western Europe and sending funds to him- and so he can finally afford to go into hospital and have another operation. It's really too bad that health care professionals are paid salaries not much higher than the minimum wage and resort to taking money from patients to better feed and educate their own children.
